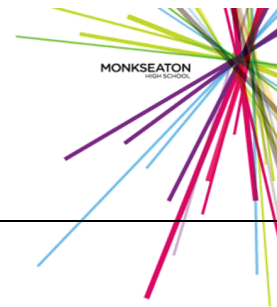

<p>Learn a selection of key quotations from 'Macbeth'.</p>	<p>Re read all of your Literature texts: 'An Inspector Calls', 'Macbeth'. 'Jekyll and Hyde' and the Power and Conflict selection from the Anthology.</p>	<p>Access Lit Charts and Sparknotes online for detailed discussion of key themes, characters and questions.</p>
<p>Create a revision card for each of the poems we have studied from the Anthology.</p>	<p>Rewrite one of your marked Literature Paper 2 responses to improve your grade.</p>	<p>Create a revision resource on key characters from 'Jekyll and Hyde' that you can display at home.</p>
