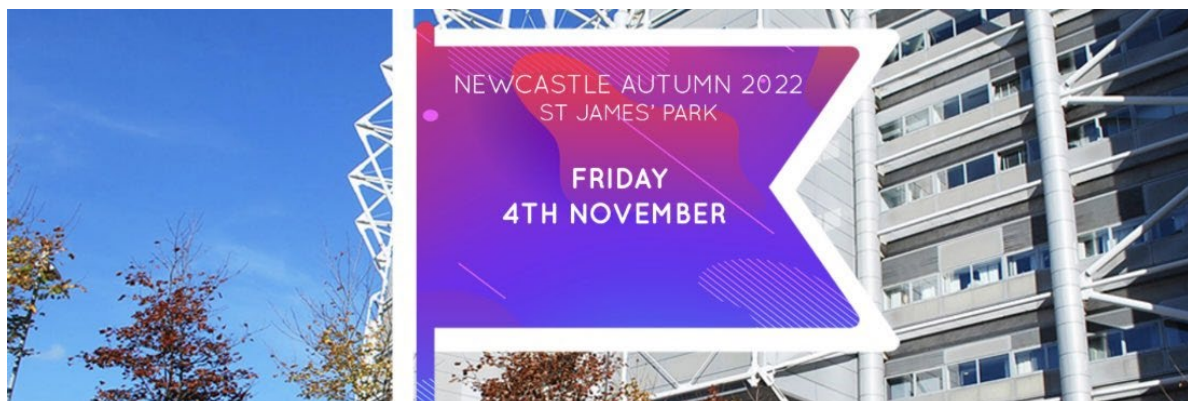




Years 12 & 13 Newsletter: December 2022
